

28<sup>th</sup> April 2014 at 8pm the local council for Lavaveix les Mines was convened and a regular council meeting held, chaired by Jean Louis Fauconnet.


The Mayor reminded the council of t	the administrative accounts'	figures for 2013, cl	osed out on 17 March 2014.




The council decided not to increase the expected figure coming from direct taxation which meant : The budgeted amount from direct taxation stands at  $187 \cdot 109 \in$ .



The mayor invited the persons present to reflect upon the projections for the 2014 budget:









The projected budget was unanimously accepted.

### Amongst the investments for 2014:

- ♦ Works on community owned buildings
- ♦ Studies on rainwater and the tennis court
- ♦ Renovation of the market square
- ♦ Upgrading housing
- ♦ Equipment purchase (canteen dishwasher, furniture)
- ♦ Water distribution lines in and around the Station section of Lavaveix
