Back to school 2014/2015

The number of pupils (not including TPS*) stands at 75 for this year's "back to school" head count. This gives a split of 56 pupils in the juniors and 19 in the infants.

Already the school year has been underway for a few days. The school this year welcomes three new arrivals ; Mme BAUDIN, teacher ; Mlle DUSQUENOY, cleaning assistant and Mme CAMELOT.

This year, the junior school section has encountered a few modifications to class structure. The class CP/GS* (19 pupils) will be held by Mme BAUDIN, CE1/CE2 by Mme MOREAU Danièle and classes CE2/CM1/CM2 (21 pupils) by Mme LEBRAT Joelle, the school head.
